## **STRUCTURE**

Adventure, comedy and fable are the framework behind the **Bitmax & Co** stories.

Each title in the series clearly focuses on a single conflict. **Bitmax & Co** is not a succession of gags, situations or scenes, but places us in the heart of the classic narrative structure that presents a conflict, develops it and solves it.

The formal diversity proposed by **Bitmax & Co** situates the reader within a complex decoding process which they can follow without getting lost, as all the information is provided in an orderly and coherent manner, with several levels of reading.




## MAIN CHARACTERS


A helpful robot, a clever rat and a kind bear are the main protagonists in Bitmax & Co.


