




## HELPING IS A GREAT **ADVENTURE!**

At Bitmax's side, Mus and Wagner discover that helping is an ongoing adventure!




## MUCH MORE THAN A CHAPTER BOOK




### MAIN CHARACTERS

Patient, naive and sweet. It takes a lot to make him angry, but when he gets angry, he's scary...


